# **BEST OF BUSINESS** WINNERS FOCUS ON EXPANSION, KEEPING EMPLOYEES HAPPY AS REGION GROWS

 he Region is on the brink of economic greatness, and our 2025 Best of Business Awards winners reflect the anticipation for the boom to come.
From new offices to new employees, many of the 2025 Best of Business winners spent last year setting the stage for growth and prosperity.

Northwest Indiana Business Magazine's 20th readers' survey honors winners in seven categories in Northwest Indiana and Michiana. Our winners excelled at providing services and products to the more than 1.4 million people who call the Region home. "The Best of Business Awards hold unique recognition for organizations that demonstrate excellence in their industries," said Rich Shields, vice president of marketing for Tech Credit Union, which has multiple locations in the Region. Shields also is a longtime member of Northwest Indiana Business Magazine's editorial



advisory board composed of business leaders and experts.

"Beyond the honor, (a Best of Business Award) often motivates businesses to continually strive for growth and leadership, making it a prestigious accolade for any recipient," Shields said.

Regional economic growth also benefited many of our winners, including McMahon & Associates CPAs PC in Munster.

"The growth in population and businesses in Northwest Indiana has provided an opportunity for our firm to have significant growth," CEO Terry McMahon said.

Heather Meyer-Schlipp, executive director of South Bend Orthopaedics, pointed to efforts in the Region to build stability.

"The stronger our Region, the stronger we are as an organization," she said.

any companies faced a positive chal-Nany companies face in the second space to grow. Kruggel Lawton CPAs based in South Bend expanded through the acquisition of a like-minded company, Cole Gavlas, based in Michigan, and moved its Elkhart office to a new facility.

"These milestones will provide many opportunities in the years ahead," said CPA Barry Hall, managing partner at Kruggel Lawton CPAs.

Granger-based Office Interiors acquired HDW Commercial Interiors in Merrillville. Both commercial design and furniture companies are Best of Business winners in their respective regions.

"(The acquisition is) very good news for our team and our clients — it's kind of a game changer," said Rita Bacevich, director of strategic initiatives for Northwest Indiana for HDW. an Office Interiors Inc. Company.

Likewise, Urschel Laboratories completed a major expansion in 2024, adding 115,000 square feet of manufacturing space to its Chesterton headguarters, and Franciscan Health Crown Point opened its new location in January, among other big projects in the Region.

"Watching our community respond to the new facility in such a positive way has been inspiring," said Dr. Daniel McCormick, president and CEO of Franciscan Health Crown Point.

Latitude Commercial, which has an office in Crown Point, has moved up its search for a bigger office to house its growing number of employees.

"Our most pressing goal is to find a new office location that can accommodate our growth and address the current issue of limited space," said Aaron McDermott, co-founder and president of Latitude.

Burke Costanza & Carberry, which has offices in Merrillville and Valparaiso, spent 2024 planning for a new La Porte location.

"As we explored a new office location, we ensured our existing operations stayed strong," said Tory Prasco, managing partner. "Strategic planning and careful site selection were exciting and challenging."

Some businesses even expanded beyond the Region's borders. Merrillvillebased Centier Bank opened branches in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis last year, plus a banking center in Cedar Lake.

"One of our goals for 2025 is to continue to expand our footprint across Indiana, so we can serve those markets with our signature brand of hospitality," said Mike Schrage, CEO and chairman of the bank.

ur winners also focused on hiring and retaining employees who fulfill the mission of their companies.

General Insurance Services based in La Porte hired from within. "Being able to provide career paths and career growth opportunities here in Northwest Indiana is absolutely core to our mission and something about which we're extremely proud," said Craig Menne, president.

Thomas Gryp, president and CEO of Notre Dame Federal Credit Union, credits staff too. "We have such an incredible group of partners (employees) that genuinely try to change a life each and every day," Gryp said. "It is that consistent effort
